

THY KINGDOM COME – AGAIN!

DEAR FRIENDS,

You may remember that this time last year we accepted the invitation of the Archbishops of Canterbury and York to join the global initiative to pray, 'Thy Kingdom Come' between Ascension Day and Pentecost. They have repeated that encouragement and this year those dates are between 10th and 20th May. As last year, we plan to pray in each church in our team – one each day at 6.30pm until Saturday 19th May, when there's a 24-hour prayer event at St Mary's, Chipping Norton.

Some of you may recall the prayer for the Queen in the Book of Common Prayer. It begins, 'Almighty God, whose kingdom is everlasting, and power infinite: have mercy on the whole Church'. It reminds me that although we might think that the Queen can do anything she wants, her kingdom and power have limits, whereas God's rule is forever and over everything that has been made. We pray to God, believing that he knows everything and loves everyone, (including us), and is working out his perfect plan.

I've recently read a couple of old biographies, 'God's Smuggler' and 'God's Smuggler to China', both of which have encouraged me to pray. Earlier in the year I also read 'Dirty Glory', by Pete Grieg, which is much more up-to-date, and terrific too. He includes many awe-inspiring stories of answered prayer, but also reminds us that many, many answered prayers are taken completely for-granted. He points out the Lord's Prayer as a powerful way of praying for God's will to be done. We may not recognise how he answers but we can be sure he does.

Let us pray ... Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.
